

Digeridoo.

1. Take two long cardboard tubes and one piece of short tube that has a piece missing out of it.
2. Put wood glue on the inside of one end of the long tubes, cover about four inches down, all the way around.
3. Put the short tube inside the long tube so it contacts the glue, but only half of its length, leave the other half sticking out.
4. Put wood glue on the inside of one end of the other long tube, cover about four inches down, all the way around.
5. Take the second long tube and connect to the piece sticking out of the first long tube.
6. In a good environment, cover a table with paper and give the long tube a base color of paint. Let dry
7. Do dot painting all over the long tube to decorate.
8. Dip one end in melted beeswax several times to make a nice soft mouthpiece for blowing into.
